Mama Jane Children Care Centre is a Charitable Non-Government Organization that was established in 1983 by an African Woman Known as Ms Jane Babirye(R.I.P) after her seeing a great need to help the African Children after the effects of the liberation wars, most of the children had lost their parents and had become homeless.

After the death of the Founder the Late Jane Babirye, the Jinja Community resolved to continue the good work left by the late Jane Babirye thus naming the Organization Mama Jane Children Care Centre in Memory of her Services.

Because of her Location, the home has cared for over 500 children since its inception.

To date Mama Jane C.C.C. accommodates 75 children institutionally and 31 children are supported on Community Based System.

The home is registered as a Non Government Organization under the Ministry of Gender, Labour and Social Development.

The Home not only does it provide services to the children but it also has an animal farm at Mpumudde which equips the grown up children with the skills of rearing animals and also providing the children with milk so they can have a balanced diet in addition to the meals provided.

However as Mpumudde was transformed into a Municipality

There came up a need to transfer the animals to Nakibizi a more remote area and to also improve on the gains from the Farm that is to say the amount of Milk produced. We have had a lot of problems as some of the animals were stolen and others died mysteriously.
